ROLE DESCRIPTION:

This wide and varied role covers all forms of site maintenance including gardening, court maintenance, painting, external cleaning and basic D.I.Y. You will work as part of a team able to tackle a variety of maintenance related issues and tasks.

SUGGESTED TIME COMMITMENT: 2 hours per week

WORKING HOURS: 2 hour shifts – fully flexible at a time to suit you

KEY TASKS:

Each shift would focus on one or more of the following tasks:

- Cutting grass
- Blowing/ clearing leaves
- Weeding
- Cutting back and pruning bushes, trees & shrubs
- Painting walls & fences
- Fixing objects/ items to walls and other surfaces
- Cleaning windows/ glass/ power-washing
- Repairing basic equipment
- Tidying/ cleaning external areas

- Physically fit and active

- Positive, optimistic, and able to work as part of a team

- Strong attention to detail

- Trustworthy and punctual

- Eager to learn new skills and processes

- Be a minimum of 16 years of age
